Specializations

Except for obligatory courses, students attend specialization courses. They may choose from the following specializations:

- European Affairs Management
- EU Funds and Programmes
- EU Diplomacy

Each academic year students are obliged to obtain 60 ECTS within obligatory and specialization courses.

Application and Admission Procedure

The programme is open to all international and Polish applicants. The following persons are eligible for admission: holders of a bachelor, master, engineer or equivalent degree in any discipline. The candidates should

also have a command of English at the B2 level confirmed by:

- a language certificate;
- an exam passed at Warsaw University Centre for Foreign Language Teaching;
- The Higher Education Diploma Supplement.

Candidates can also take an oral exam to prove his/her language skills.

Qualification procedure is based on the final Higher Education Diploma Grade converted into points according to the following rules:

Diploma Grade	Points
excellent or very good (6 or 5)	100
good plus (4+)	80
good (4)	60
satisfactory plus (3+)	40
satisfactory (3)	20

A candidate's final score varies between 20 and 100 points. The qualification depends on the candidate's place on the rank list.

Tuition Fee

Tuition fee for the 2017/2018 academic year:

EU/EFTA citizens and other students admitted on equal terms with Polish citizens:

- 3500 EUR/year (full time)
- 2900 EUR/year (part time)

Other international students admitted on fee-paying basis:

- 3500 EUR/year + 200 EUR (full time)
- 2900 EUR/year + 200 EUR (part time)
